3.3 GPA Appeal Criteria	Required Documents
Disability	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A statement from the student describing fully the reason(s) for the appeal • Documentation of students disability
Serious illness or injury of student	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A statement from the student describing fully the reason(s) for the appeal • Note from physician
Pregnancy or adoption	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A statement from the student describing fully the reason(s) for the appeal • Documentation/note from a physician
Serious illness/death of immediate family	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A statement from the student describing fully the reason(s) for the appeal • Note from physician or death certificate
Other serious personal difficulties	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A statement from the student describing fully the reason(s) for the appeal • Appropriate supporting documentation/Note from advisor, psychologist, social worker, etc.
Fulfillment of military service	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A statement from the student describing fully the reason(s) for the appeal • Documentation of military orders
Extreme financial hardship	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A statement from the student describing fully the reason(s) for the appeal • Student and spouse/parent (if dependent) 2021 and 2022 IRS Tax Return Transcript or 1040 Signed Federal Tax Return, and W2 forms • Documentation of student and spouse/parent expected 2023 income (Copies of pay stubs, unemployment benefits, and other untaxed income) • Supporting documentation that details financial hardship, such as: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> o Written notice of involuntary job termination or layoff o Copies of severance pay or any benefits o Loss of child support
