## **AWARD**

The amount of the EA Grant is up to \$3,000. Students with the lowest EFC are awarded first.

## **HOW TO APPLY**

- 1. Complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) or the Maryland State Financial Aid Application (MSFAA), if ineligible to complete the FAFSA but are eligible to receive in-state tuition on or before **March 1**.
- 2. List at least one Maryland college or university on the FAFSA.
- 3. Submit all documents (if required) by March 1.

## **ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS**

- You and your parents (if you are a dependent student) must be Maryland residents.
- You must enroll at a two-year or four-year Maryland college or university\* as a full-time (12+ credits per semester), degree seeking, undergraduate student. Audited courses cannot be used to reach the minimum credit hours required for full-time status.
- You must demonstrate financial need. All applicants are ranked by Expected Family Contribution (EFC). Your EFC is based on information reported on the FAFSA/MSFAA.
