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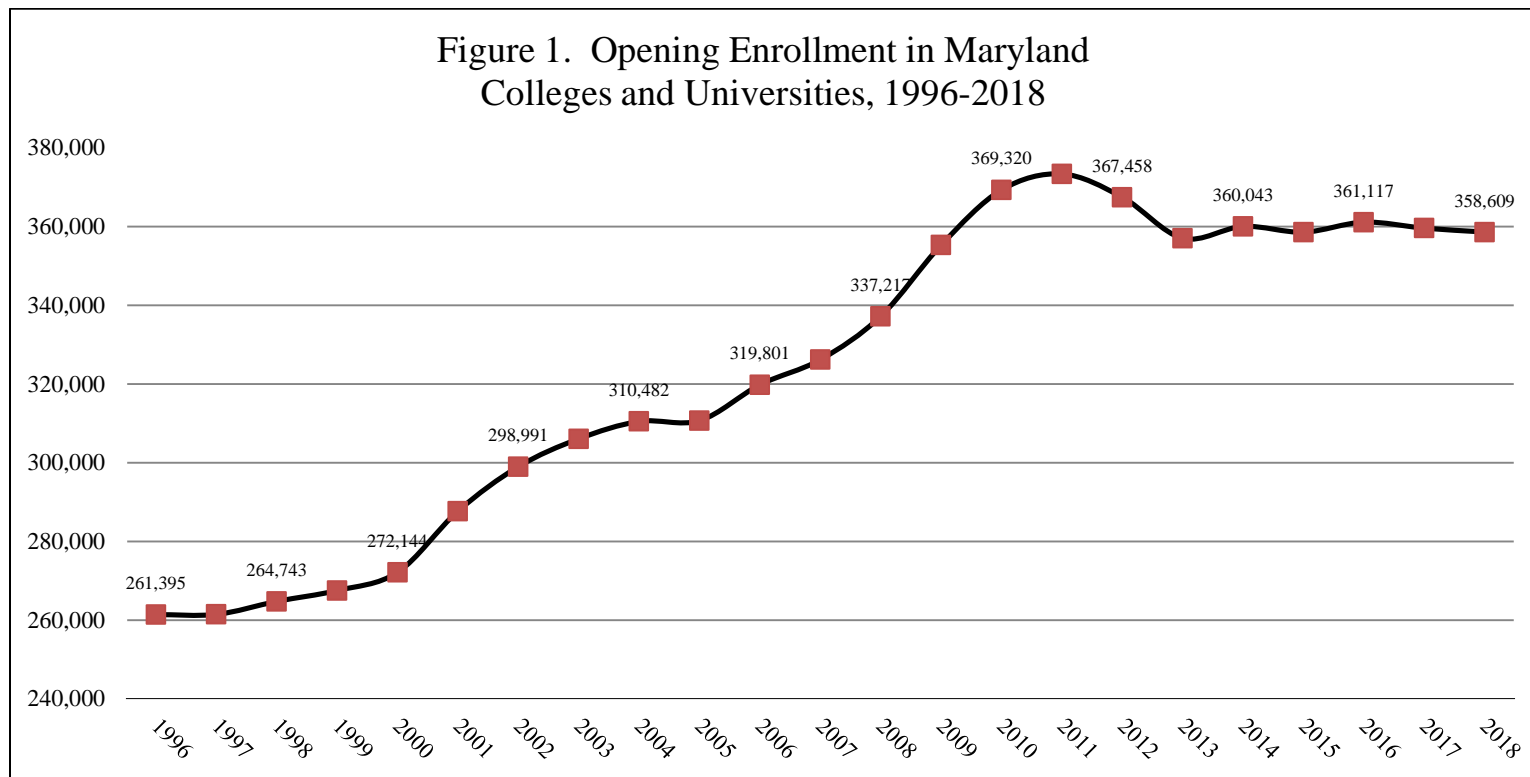
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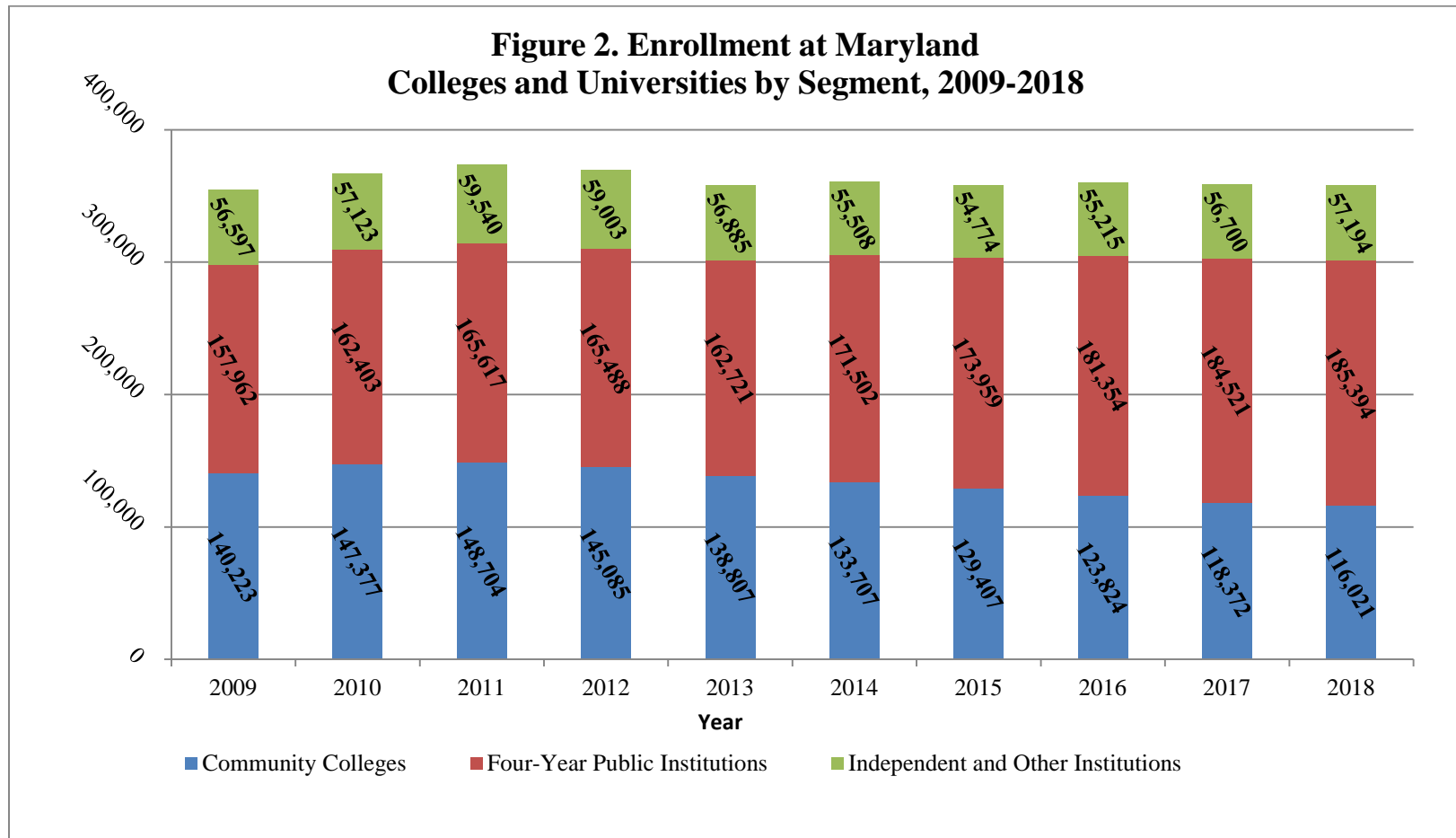
Opening Fall Enrollment, Fall 2018¹

- The total headcount enrollment at all Maryland institutions is 358,609, a decrease of 984 (or 0.3%) from the Fall 2017 enrollment of 359,593. This is the sixth consecutive year in which enrollment has been between 357,000 and 362,000, indicating that enrollment is generally stable. The continuous growth of the 2000 to 2012 period, especially the rapid growth between 2008 and 2012, has ended. As shown in Figure 1, this year's headcount enrollment total is 14,750 (or 4.0%) lower than the all-time high of 373,359 in Fall 2011 and 1,573 (or 0.4%) higher than the six-year low of 357,036 in Fall 2013.



¹This report highlights preliminary data on fall enrollment submitted by Maryland colleges and universities. Final enrollment figures presented later in the term may differ slightly from those included in this report.

- Enrollment changes varied by sector, as shown in Figure 2. The number of students enrolling at community colleges declined for the seventh consecutive year, from 118,372 to 116,021 (or 2.0%). This is the lowest enrollment since 2005, when 119,142 were enrolled. Of Maryland's 16 community colleges, 12 experienced declines in enrollment. Four community colleges experienced increases in enrollment: Baltimore City Community College (from 3,493 to 4,557, an increase of 30.5%), Carroll Community College (from 3,009 to 3,050, an increase of 1.4%), Garrett College (from 621 to 658, an increase of 6.0%), and Hagerstown Community College (from 4,069 to 4,148, a 1.9% increase). Montgomery College experienced the largest percentage decrease in enrollment and the largest decrease by number of students (1,155, or 5.0%), from 22,875 to 21,720.



- The decrease in enrollment at community colleges during Fall 2018 may be related to declining unemployment. Community college enrollment increased during the Great Recession from Fall 2007 to 2011 as unemployment increased, because unemployed individuals are more likely to attend college.² As the Maryland unemployment rate has decreased, community college enrollment has decreased along with it. For example, in 2010 when unemployment in the state peaked, Maryland's unemployment rate was 7.7%.³ During that same time, enrollment at community colleges was 147,377. By 2017, Maryland's unemployment rate was 4.2%,⁴ a 3.5 point decrease from 2010, and enrollment at community colleges during that time was 118,372. This is consistent with a relationship between unemployment and college enrollment. This is not affecting four-year schools in the same way because older adults and non-traditional students are more likely to enroll at community colleges.
- Undergraduate enrollment at Maryland colleges and universities declined by 973 (or 0.3%), from 286,898 to 285,925. Part-time undergraduate enrollment increased by 1,207 (or 0.9%) from 130,035 to 131,242. Full-time undergraduate enrollment declined by 1.4%, from 156,863 to 154,683.
- Graduate enrollment at Maryland colleges and universities decreased marginally by 11 (0.0%), from 72,695 to 72,684. This included an increase in full-time enrollment (1.4%, from 30,716 to 31,153) and a decrease in part-time enrollment (1.1%, from 41,979 to 41,531).
- Enrollment at public four-year institutions grew by 0.5%, from 184,521 to 185,394. This difference was driven by changes in the number of part-time students: part-time undergraduate enrollment increased by 1,714 (from 47,550 to 49,264, an increase of 3.6%), while part-time graduate enrollment decreased by 753 (from 24,606 to 23,853, a decrease of 3.1%). The magnitude of changes in total enrollment, whether positive or negative, was rather small at most institutions. Nine institutions saw enrollments within 2% of 2017 enrollment. The largest percentage decreases occurred at the University of Baltimore (a 9.4% decrease, from 5,565 to 5,041), the University of Maryland Eastern Shore (an 8.5% decrease, from 3,490 to 3,193), and Coppin State University (a 5.4% decrease, from 2,893 to 2,738). This is the third consecutive year in which these three institutions have experienced declines. Since Fall 2015, total enrollment at UMES has decreased by 21.8%, at UB by 10.7%, and at Coppin by 6.9%. By

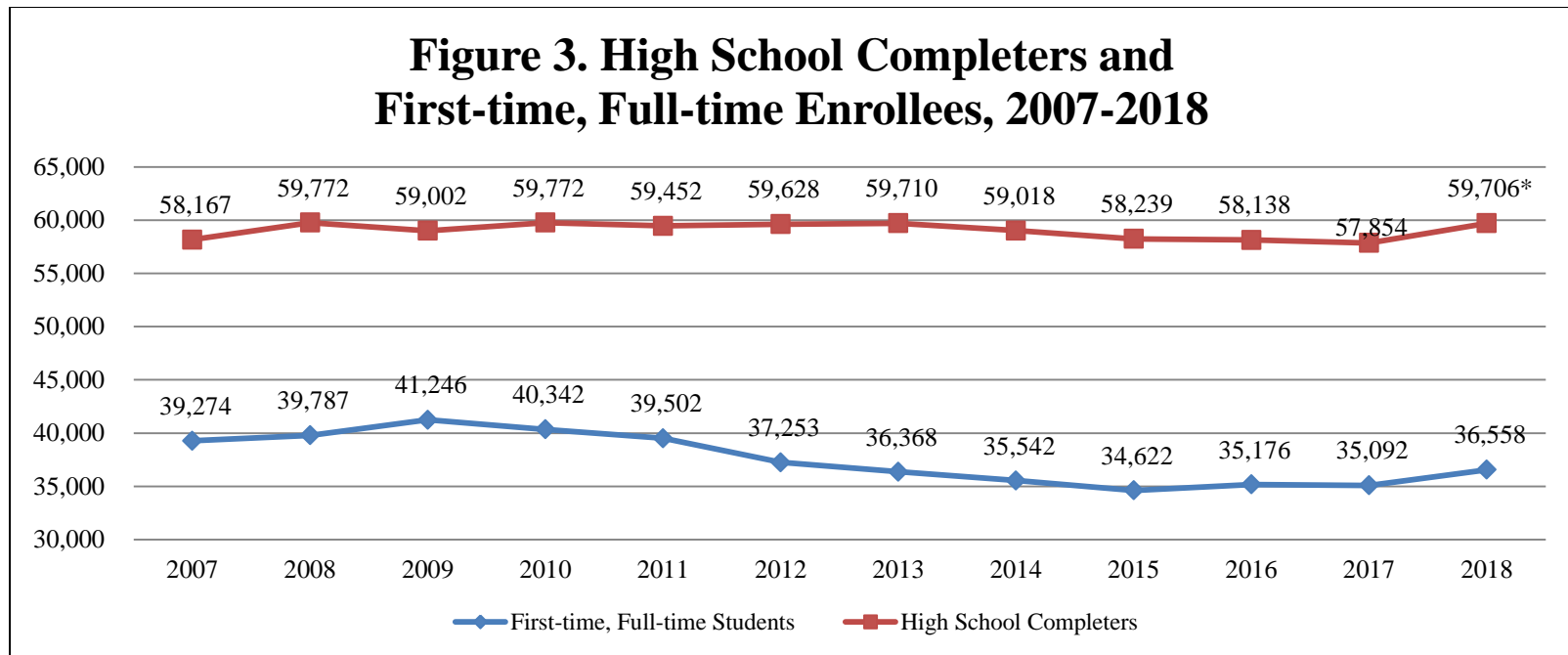

contrast, Bowie State University experienced the highest percentage growth for the second consecutive year (from 6,148 to 6,320, a 2.8% increase, after an 8.4% increase from 2016 to 2017, for a total two-year increase of 11.5%).

- Total enrollment at all private institutions grew slightly (494 or 0.9%), from 56,700 to 57,194. This was driven by an increase in enrollment at state-aided independent institutions, where total enrollment increased by 393 or 0.7%, from 52,768 to 53,161. The main source of this increased enrollment at state-aided independent institutions was Johns Hopkins University, where enrollment rose from 25,151 to 26,152 (an increase of 4.0%). Six of the 13 state-aided independent institutions saw enrollment declines.
- Enrollment at non-state-aided private institutions increased from 3,932 to 4,033 (up 2.6%). Among the 11 non-state-aided private institutions, seven saw increases in enrollment compared to last year where only three institutions saw increases. Two of these institutions are new (Faith Theological Seminary and Reid Temple Bible College). One institution, Binah Institute of Advanced Judaic Studies for Women, discontinued operations.
- The number of first-time, full-time students increased in Fall 2018 and is the highest it has been since 2012. As Figure 3 on the next page shows, the number of first-time, full-time students increased by 4.2%, from 35,092 to 36,558. Community colleges saw a 0.6% decrease in the number of first-time, full-time students, declining from 12,650 to 12,571. Across all public four-year institutions, the number of first-time, full-time students increased from 15,675 to 16,623, a 6.0% increase. The University of Maryland College Park increased first-time, full-time enrollment by 865, from 5,187 to 6,052 (a 16.7% increase), and Towson University increased first-time, full-time enrollment by 255, from 2,735 to 2,990 (a 9.3% increase). The number of first-time, full-time students declined most substantially at Bowie State University, where enrollment decreased by 181 students, from 1,079 to 898 (a 16.8% decrease). Additionally, while first-time, full-time enrollment decreased by only 31 at the University of Baltimore, this represents a 29.0% decline. State-aided independent institutions experienced a nominal increase of 22 first-time, full-time enrollments, from 6,033 to 6,055 (a 0.4% increase). Other private institutions increased their first-time, full-time enrollments by 575 (a 78.0% increase), from 734 to 1,309.

- The increase in first-time, full-time students appears to be driven by an increase in the number of public high school completers, as shown in Figure 3. Although the Maryland State Department of Education has not yet released data on the number of high school completers in 2017–2018, the number of 12th grade students enrolled in 2017–2018 was larger than the number of 12th grade students in 2016–2017, and so MHEC estimates that the number of high school completers will also increase slightly.⁵ The ratio of first-time, full-time students to public high school completers declined from an average of .67 in the years 2005–2011 to an average of .61 in the years 2012–2017. MHEC is conducting additional research to identify changes in college-going patterns.
